## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON PROPOSED SEWAGE WORKS RATES, CHARGES, AND FEES FOR THE CITY OF BUTLER, INDIANA

Property owners, ratepayers and other interested parties in, served by or to be served by the Sewage Works of the City of Butler, Indiana (the "Sewage Works"), are hereby notified that an ordinance (the "Rate Ordinance") amending rates, charges, and fees for services to be rendered by the Sewage Works, was introduced at a meeting of the Common Council of the City of Butler, Indiana, held on February 20, 2023. At a meeting of the Common Council to be held at 7:00 p.m., local time, on March 20, 2023, at City Hall, located at 215 South Broadway Street, Butler, Indiana, there will be a public hearing on the matter of the rates, charges, and fees consideration of adoption of said Rate Ordinance, which provides in part as follows:

The Rate Ordinance provides for an increase in rates and charges as set forth below:

(C) There are established for the use of and the services rendered by the sewage works system of the city, the following rates and charges based on the water supplied by the water works system to each billing unit.
