Acting Mayor Ron Walter declared the Public Hearing for the Library Capital Projects Plan open at 7:32 pm.

Library Director Ellen Stuckey reported that she is asking for \$13,500 for technical assistance this year. This money would be used to add 15 new computers and upgrade 10 existing computers.


Last year the Butler Public Library hosted 675 different events. Over 55,000 items were circulated and they now have over 2,000 card holders.

The Library was honored to be named a 4 Star Library by the Library Journal. There were only eleven libraries in the State of Indiana that received this honor.

The Dedication of the new building will be August 15.

Acting Mayor Walter asked for comments or questions from the audience. Jim Nichols stated that the Library does a wonderful job and that he appreciates all of the hard work that they do for the community.
